COVID-19 Health and Safety Policy

Effective 6/15/2021

- **Mask** – According to CDC COVID-19 Guidelines, fully vaccinated staff, volunteers, and guests to Habitat facilities and construction sites are not required to wear a mask. Furthermore, unvaccinated staff, volunteers, and guests are encouraged to wear a mask in accordance with the same guidelines.
- **Symptoms** – If you are not vaccinated and have symptoms of COVID-19, do not come to work and seek medical care.
- **Diagnosed** – If you are diagnosed with COVID-19 you need to ISOLATE for at least 10 days from the date symptoms first appeared and it has been at least 24 hours with no fever (without taking medication to lower temperature) and other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving.
- **Exposure** – If you are exposed to someone with COVID-19 you must to QUARANTINE for 14 days unless:
 1. You are fully vaccinated (it has been at least two weeks since the second dose of a 2 dose vaccine or two weeks after a single dose vaccine) and you have no symptoms; or
 2. You had COVID-19 within the past three months and you have no symptoms.

All persons should monitor for symptoms for 14 days. If you develop symptoms, do not come to work and seek medical care. You can shorten your quarantine if you have gone for 10 days without symptoms will wear a mask and social distance until 14 days. You can also shorten quarantine if they have gone for 7 days without symptoms and have a negative test (which has to be done after day 5), but you must wear a mask and social distance for 14 days.
